- **Arts Festival** A spring event used to celebrate arts and raise money for arts programs at Monroe. Each class paints a canvas that is auctioned in a live auction. A silent auction with other art items is also held.
- **Assemblies/Good Morning Monroe** Assemblies are coordinated through the Music Department. They start at 7:50 am most Fridays. In September we will hold a special Grandparents Day Assembly and on or near Veteran's Day we hold an assembly to honor Veterans in our Monroe families.
- Bell Schedule
 - 7:25 am School is unlocked and students are allowed in the school.
 - 7:50 am Tardy Bell (report to office before going to class)
 - 2:50 pm Afternoon Dismissal
- Birthdays (Student's) Check with your student's teacher about classroom birthday celebrations.
- **Book Fair** There are two Book Fairs at Monroe, one in the fall and the other in the spring. They are typically scheduled to coincide with Parent/Teacher Conferences. Details to come in the Mustang Messenger.
- **C.A.R.E.S. Cards** These are given to students by staff throughout the building who "catch" kids demonstrating Cooperation, Awesome Attitude, Respect, Empathy and Self Control. Each week, all the C.A.R.E.S. cards are put in a drawing by grade level and one student from each grade level is recognized as the C.A.R.E.S. card winner of the week.
- Class Parties There are 3 designated "Party" Days (Fall, Holiday/Winter, and Valentine/50s Day) Look for emails and sign-up genius for opportunities to help from Classroom Parents.
- **Community Nights** Be sure to mark your calendar for our Community Nights that are scheduled. Make dinner or shopping easy and help out the PTA at the same time. Mention Monroe PTA and the restaurants or stores will donate a portion to the school!
- **Curriculum Nights** Monroe will have curriculum night in the fall. This is a time for parents to hear about grade-specific curriculum, expectations and classroom procedures. Details will be shared in the Mustang Messenger.
- **Facebook** Be sure to LIKE "Monroe Elementary PTA-Norman" on Facebook for PTA updates and information. In addition, the official school page, MonroeCARES, is a valuable source of information from school and district administration.
- **Family Fun Night** In the Spring a fun night for the entire family, complete with games, prizes, a raffle and more!
- **Fifties Day** Held in conjunction with Valentine's parties every year, on Fifties Day, students and staff dress in Fifties style clothes and participate in an assembly with Fifties era music and dancing.
- **Girls on the Run** A 10 week after school program for 3rd-5th grade girls created to inspire girls to be joyful, healthy and confident using a fun, experienced based curriculum which creatively integrates running, Takes place Spring Semester.



- **Hat Days** These are held monthly on Fridays. Students are permitted to wear a hat if they bring \$1 to donate to the fund our school counselor uses to support families in need at Monroe.
- **Helping Hands** A school wide food drive, food pantry, and clothing/book exchange that takes place during fall and spring P/T conferences as well as at the holidays.
- **Holiday Market** A shopping opportunity for your student to select and purchase holiday gifts for the family. This event is held during the school day. Planning begins in September, with the event in December. Volunteers are needed as shopping and gift-wrapping assistants and cashiers.
- **Holiday Meal** Every year NPS host a Holiday Meal before Thanksgiving Break. Parent Volunteers help serve the students a traditional Holiday Meal including a special treat at the end! This event is currently tentative.
- **Instagram** Follow MonroeMustangPTA on Instagram to see posts about news, activities and events at Monroe.
- **Jog-A-Thon** Held in the fall, this is PTA's main fundraiser for the year. Each child is asked to participate in the event and in fundraising. It's a fun-filled day with a DJ, snacks and laughing!
- **Kindness Week** A national celebration of kindness in late January. At Monroe we observe Kindness Week by encouraging different kind activities each day of the week.
- Last Day of School Information on our last day of school activities will be communicated in the Mustang Messenger. This day is filled with fun and celebrations!
- **Library** Each class visits the library on a regular basis and participates in lessons with our librarian.

- **Manyawi!** 4th and 5th grade global music program, consisting of approx. 40 to 50 students. Meets two days a week to explore music and games from various cultures. Students perform on Monroe's many wonderful world instruments, including our marimbas and tubanos.
- **Make it Neat** Every year before school starts Monroe families meet on a Saturday morning to visit and get our incredible building ready for school. We do yard work, clean and organizing the workroom, and distribute signage and supplies throughout the school.
- **Monroe Cares** Monroe sponsorship campaign to raise money to provide materials needed to maintain a safe and healthy school environment and to provide art enrichment throughout the year.
- Monroe Champions A group of community, families, and friends committed to empowering teachers
 through volunteering in various ways in the classroom, library, gymnasium, and cafeteria. From leading
 reading groups with students to helping put up a bulletin board and everything in between, we get to come
 alongside our Monroe teachers and partner with them on a consistent basis to encourage, empower and
 champion our educators as they invest in our students!
- **Music/PE Days** These classes, referred to as "specials" are on a 3 day rotation: music, music, PE. If a grade level has 4 classes, one class will be split into thirds.
- **Mustang Top 5** This weekly publication is distributed by the PTA. It contains the five hottest pieces of info for you to remember for the coming week. It comes to your email inbox via PeachJar and is also posted on social media.



- **NPS Mobile App** The Norman Public School District mobile app provides news and info about schools across the district. The free app is available on both Apple and Android devices and gives access to news, calendars, Parent Portal accounts, lunch menus and more. Users can choose to receive push notifications.
- **Parking** Please do not park in the loop at the front of the school at drop-off or pick-up times. This blocks buses and NPS vehicles which transport students. There is parking in both north and south lots as well as on the nearby streets.
- **Peach Jar** Norman Public Schools uses this service to send out school, class and community announcements. Keep your eye out for these throughout the school year.
- **Pumpkin Patch** Held in our Outdoor Classroom, The Pumpkin Patch is a fall themed experience run by volunteers that each class is able to visit. Students play games and pick out a small pumpkin to take home.
- **School Check-In** Parents and visitors must always check-in with the front office for a name tag, even on school party days. Every visitor MUST present his/her Photo ID or digital ID to get a name tag, no exceptions.
- **School Supplies** Each year NPS provides a list of supplies needed for each student. The PTA sells packets of supplies for your convenience. There are many teachers in the school who are not homeroom teachers (music, library, PE, reading, etc.) and in turn, do not receive supplies from students for their classrooms. If you are able, check with them to see if you can help provide basic supplies that might be needed (Kleenex, Clorox wipes, chalk, markers etc.).
- **Signup Genius** This is the method that PTA uses to fill volunteer opportunities throughout the year. The links are posted on our Facebook page and sent via email. Be sure to like our Facebook page and signup for PTA emails! These signups are used for everything from staff appreciation lunches, class parties and everything in between.
- **Special Decorations** Volunteers decorate the building, classrooms, or gym for different events throughout the school year.
- **Staff Appreciation** PTA sponsors monthly Staff Appreciation meals and treats to pamper our amazing teachers. Each grade level is responsible for a month for lunch and there is a sign-up for the monthly gifts. We also observe a week of appreciating our faculty and staff in early May.
- **Super Stuemky Day** (Formerly known as Super Kid's Day) A fun day in May when all students are involved in a variety of physical (fun) activities. Students will participate with a partner of comparable size and ability. This is an excellent way to provide each student with maximum participation and many successful experiences.
- **Teacher Notebook** There is a "My Favorite Things" notebook in the teacher's workroom, organized by grade and teacher. Each teacher has filled out a form, with his/her favorite things. It's a great resource for gift ideas! This will also be shared via the Mustang Messenger.
- T-Shirts Monroe t-shirts are sold several times throughout the year at www.monroepta.org. Various shirt
 designs are offered to appeal to students, teachers and parents. Long sleeve and cold weather options are
 offered later in the fall.
- **Watch D.O.G.S.** (Dads of Great Students) This is a group of male volunteers (dads, granddads, etc.) who volunteer their time at Monroe. Contact Josh Edge at 405.659.8981 or joshmedge@gmail.com.
